## **CANNONS' LAST GAME (AUGUST 2 VS. PHILADELPHIA)**

Goalie **Kevin Keenan** (Penn State '00) stopped 27 of the 38 shots he faced to earn Bud Light MVP honors as the Boston Cannons were defeated by the Philadelphia Barrage, 16-11, before 8,648 fans at Harvard Stadium on August 2. The Cannons got on the scoreboard first, and were up by a score of 5-2 early in the second quarter, but the Barrage stole the momentum from there and netted eight unanswered goals, including two two-point tallies, to capture a 12-5 advantage. The Barrage continued their stronghold in the second half, while the Cannons ran out of time in their fourth quarter comeback effort, falling to the defending MLL Champion Barrage by a score of 16-11. Attackman **Mikey Powell** (Syracuse '04) led the Cannons with four goals in the game. Cannons goalie **Kip Turner** (Virginia '07) took the loss with 26 saves on the 40 shots he faced in the contest.

## **DENVER'S LAST GAME (JULY 26 VS. CHICAGO)**

The Denver Outlaws defeated the Chicago Machine, 15-13, to clinch the Western Conference Championship at INVESCO Field at Mile High on July 26. Attackmen **Brendan Mundorf** (UMBC '06) and **Ryan Powell** (Syracuse '00) each had three goals for the Outlaws but were overshadowed by midfielder **Brian Langtry** (Hofstra '01) who scored four goals and one assist to earn Bud Light MVP honors in the match-up. With less than five minutes to play in the game, the score was tied at 13-13 before Powell tallied the game winning goal, assisted by midfielder **Drew Westervelt** (UMBC '07). Langtry opened up the scoring 33 seconds into the game and closed it out with 2:55 left to play in the fourth quarter. With the win, the Outlaws finished the season undefeated at home and won the season series, 2-1, against the Machine.

## NEWS & NOTES

**A City Fit For A Champion:** The Steinfeld Trophy, given to the league's champion, will be raised in Boston in 2008 as *NB Zip* MLL Championship Weekend returns to the city for the first time since the event was here in 2005 at Boston University's Nickerson Field. The Semifinal games will be held at 12:00 PM and 3:00 PM on Saturday, August 23 and the two Semifinal winners will advance to the *NB Zip* MLL Championship Game on Sunday, August 24. The Championship game and the first Semifinal game will both air live on ESPN2.

**First Time For Everything:** Tonight's match-up between the Cannons and the Denver Outlaws, who were added to MLL during the four-team Western expansion in 2006, will represent the first time in league-history that the two teams have played each other. The Cannons and Outlaws are the last two teams in the league that have yet to face each other in a regular season game.

**In The Record Books:** Heading into this weekend's action, midfielder **Matt Poskay** is tied for second in league history for most goals scored in one season by a midfielder. With 32 goals, he is tied with former Long Island midfielder **Jay Jalbert** (2002 and 2003) and former Baltimore midfielder **Gary Gait** (2004), while former Philadelphia midfielder **Blake Miller** set the record with 46 goals during the 2004 season.

**Career Year For Poskay:** Midfielder **Matt Poskay** has already broken his previous season-highs for scoring, and his 32 goals are currently ranked fourth in the league overall, and first in the league among midfielders. His 32 goals also lead the Cannons, as do his 38 total points, through 11 games. In 2007, Poskay tallied 21 goals and 23 overall points in 12 games, and in 2006, he netted his previous career-best 25 goals and 26 overall points in the eight games he played in as the Cannons' Rookie of the Year.

**Not A Rookie Move:** Midfielder **Paul Rabil** is ranked third on the team in scoring with 32 total points in just eight games played, his 22 goals are second amongst Cannons midfielders and his 50 shots on goal are third on the team. In addition, the rookie leads all Cannons players and rookies league-wide with three two-point goals, and is tied for the league's single-season record for two-point goals scored by a rookie. Since Rabil made his MLL debut on June 7 at New Jersey, the Cannons have posted a record of 5-3.

**Last Line Of Defense:** Goalie **Kip Turner**, who is ranked third in the league with a 13.51 goals-against average heading into this weekend, has posted six wins so far this season, good for third-best in the league. Turner earned MLL Goalkeeper of the Week honors after his 16 save effort to lead the Cannons to a 14-10 victory over Washington in his home town of Annapolis, Maryland, on July 19, and since officially being named as the team's starter on June 3, Turner has put together a 5-3 record.

**Shorthanded Success:** Heading into this weekend's action, the Cannons are tied for first in the league with three shorthanded goals this season. Rochester is the only other team to collect as many shorthanded tallies as the Cannons. In addition, the Cannons have only allowed one shorthanded goal this season.

**They Add Up Quick:** The Cannons have scored the most two-point goals of any team in the league so far this season with seven two-point tallies. The Cannons also are tied for the season record for two-pointers in one game, with three scored against Long Island on May 31.

**Take Your Best Shot:** The Cannons currently lead the league with 376 shots on goal.

**Morris Lends A Helping Hand:** Attackman **Sean Morris**, who is currently the Cannons team leader with 16 assists, collected eight points (2 goals, 6 assists) in his first game as a Cannon at Long Island on May 31, and his six assists remain a league-high for the season.

**Poskay Scores When It Counts:** Heading into this weekend's action, midfielder **Matt Poskay** leads the league with three game-winning goals this season.

**Cannons 2008 Bud Light MVPs:** Attackman **Sean Morris** earned Bud Light MVP honors for his four-goal performance in the Cannons' 14-10 victory over Washington on July 19; midfielder **John Christmas** earned the Bud Light MVP award for his thrilling game-winning goal in the final seconds against Long Island on July 12; attackman **Mikey Powell** collected three goals and five assists in San Francisco on June 28 to earn the Bud Light MVP award; midfielder **Paul Rabil** earned Bud Light MVP honors after his five points (4-1=5) in the Cannons 14-12 victory over Washington on June 19; and midfielder **Matt Poskay** earned the award in each of the Cannons' first two wins this season. Poskay tallied five goals in the Cannons' 17-8 win against New Jersey on June 6, and he put together a three-goal effort in the Cannons' 13-9 victory over New Jersey in the season-opening game on May 17.

**Feeling Better Already:** The Cannons' sixth win of the season against Washington on July 19 gave them more wins for this season than they collected during their entire 2007 campaign.

**Seeing Stars:** Midfielders **Matt Poskay**, **Paul Rabil**, and **Tom Zummo** and defenseman **Chris Passavia** all represented the Cannons in the 2008 MLL All-Star Game at INVESCO Field at Mile High in Denver, CO. Rabil was one of three rookies selected to the team, while Poskay scored four goals and was named the Bud Light MVP in the 2007 All-Star game held in Boston. The four were joined in Denver by Head Coach **Bill Daye**, who coached in his third All-Star Game.

**Poskay Earns League Recognition:** Midfielder **Matt Poskay's** career-high six goals in the Cannons' July 12 win over the Long Island Lizards earned him the MLL's Offensive Player of the Week award.

**Never Too Late To Start:** The game-winning goal against Long Island on July 12 by midfielder **John Christmas** was the first of his career.

**Jack Of All Trades:** Defensive-minded midfielder **Brian Jacovina** collected the first goal of his MLL career in the Cannons' 13-12 victory over Long Island on July 12.

**Zummo Gets Revenge:** Midfielder **Tom Zummo** posted a career-high five goals in his first game against his former team, as the Cannons defeated San Francisco by a score of 21-14 on June 28. Prior to his five goal game, Zummo's career-high was a four goal effort posted against Chicago on July 8, 2006.

**Powell Wins League Award:** Attackman Mikey Powell, who missed three games early in the season with a hamstring injury, collected eight points in the Cannons 21-14 victory over San Francisco on June 28. His three goals and five assists earned him the MLL's Offensive Player of the Week award, as well as Bud Light MVP honors in the contest.

**Cannons On TV:** This season marks the first time in the organization's history that all 12 Cannons games will be televised in the New England area, and 11 of the 12 games will be aired live. Three networks – Comcast SportsNet New England, CN8 and ESPN2 – will combine to televise the games. Cannons television play-by-play announcer **Jason Chandler** and color commentator **Jack Piatelli** will return to broadcast the Cannons' local home games this season.

**Megill Chips In:** Defenseman **Ray Megill** collected his first career goal against Washington on June 19, en route to a Cannons 14-12 win.

**Rookie Shines In Home Debut:** Midfielder **Paul Rabil** was named as the *Cascade* MLL Rookie of the Week after his four goal and one assist performance in the Cannons' 14-12 win over Washington on June 19. The game was the first at Harvard Stadium for Rabil.

**First Goal For First Overall Pick:** Midfielder **Paul Rabil** tallied his first career MLL goal in his MLL debut at New Jersey on June 6. A 2008 graduate of Johns Hopkins and the Cannons' first overall selection in the 2008 MLL Collegiate Draft on May 28, Rabil led Johns Hopkins in scoring for the third straight time this season as he totaled a career-high 36 goals and 14 assists for 50 points.

The 2008 collegiate draft marked the first time in Cannons team history that they held the first overall pick, which they acquired from Chicago in exchange for the fourth and sixth overall selections.
